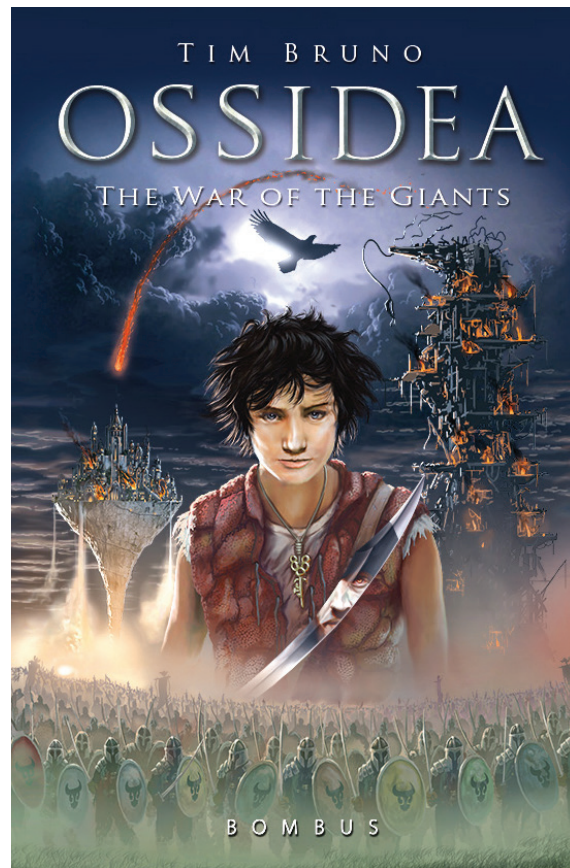

BOOK SYNOPSIS
